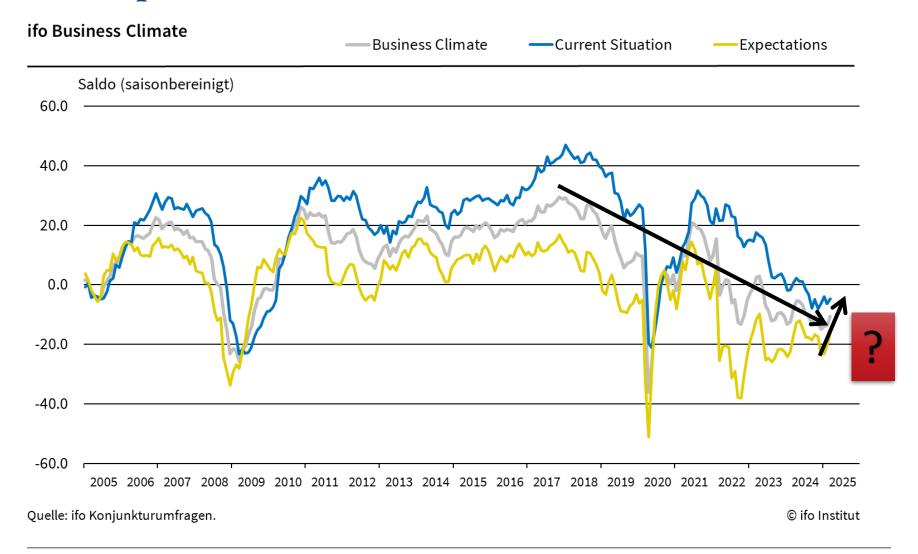

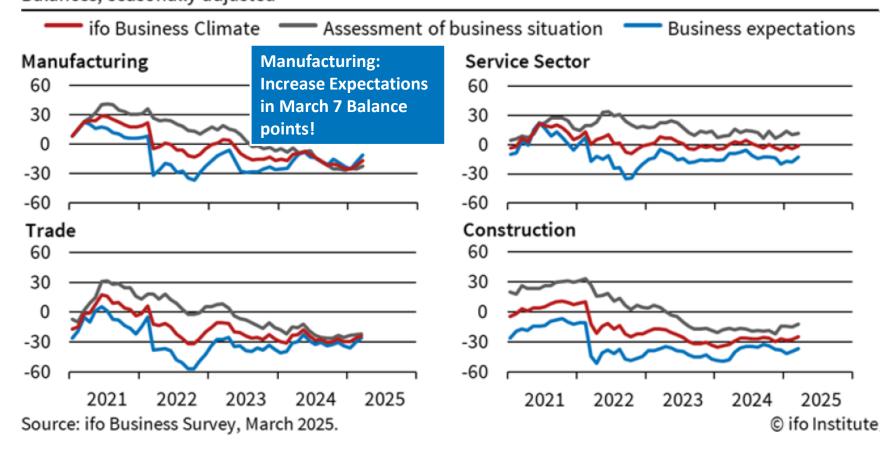

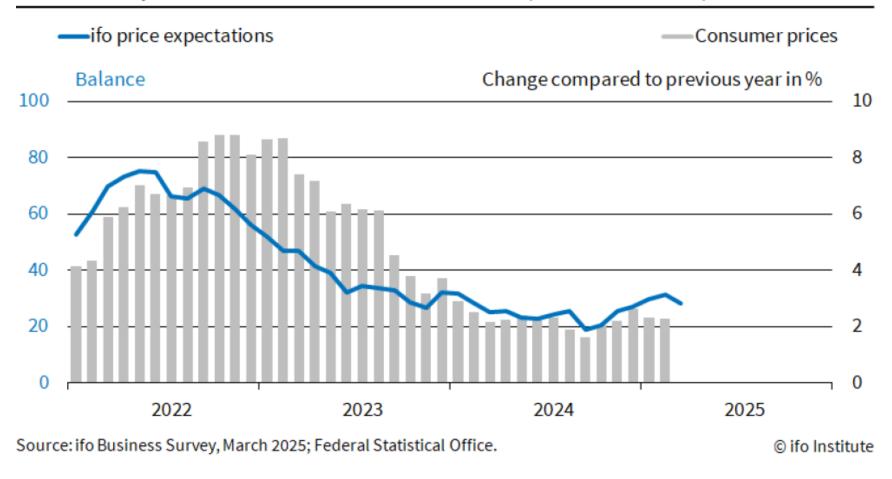
ifo Business Climate, Business Situation, and Expectations by Sector Balances, seasonally adjusted

Price Development for Consumer-Related Services (incl. Retail Trade)

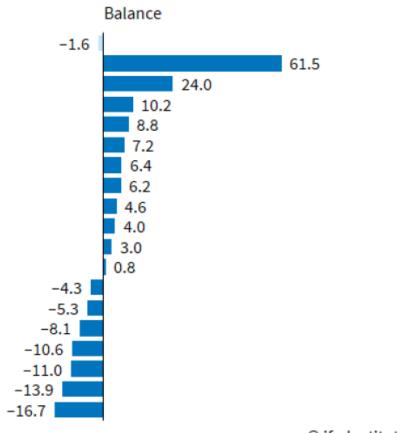


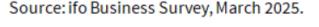

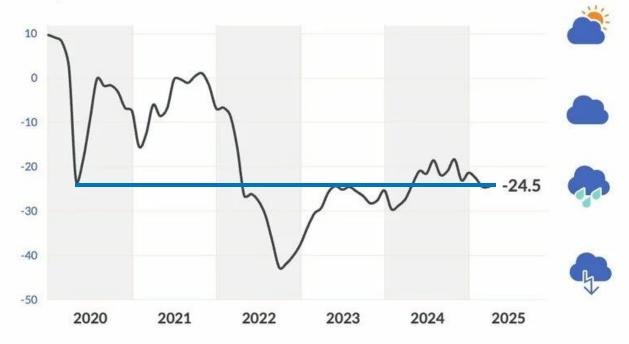
Consumer Climate: Persistent fears and uncertainty

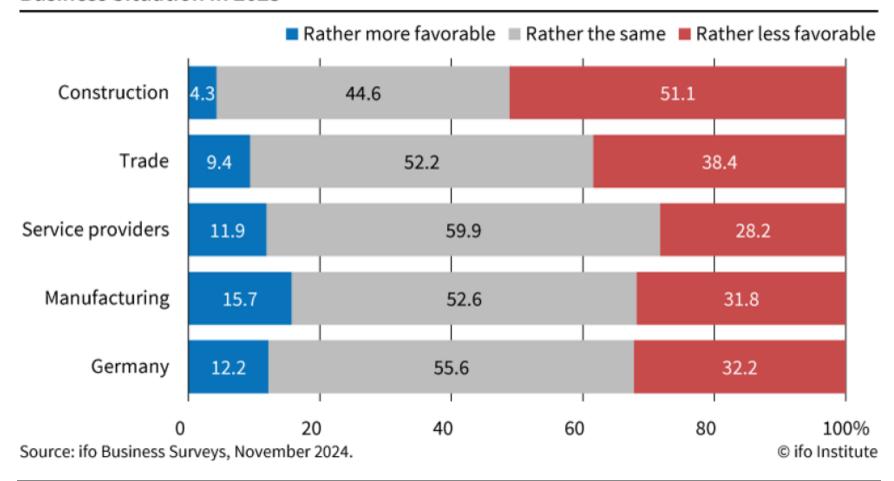
Helpful additions to standard survey questions: Ad hoc or special questions

- Ad hoc questions where part of the questionnaire occasionally since 1990ies at the ifo
- Examples include: Extreme weather, climate change (2013), Introduction of Minimum wage (2015), US Tax reform (2018)
- Regular inclusion of special questions since Covid 19
- The focus is always on the impact on and reaction of firms
- Questions are about about actual issues no planned or potential ones
- Support evidence-based policy advice: Enable targeted recommendations for policymakers based on current business sentiment.
- React to current events and disruptions: Quickly capture business reactions to unforeseen developments (e.g. Trump's re-election, geopolitical shocks, pandemics).

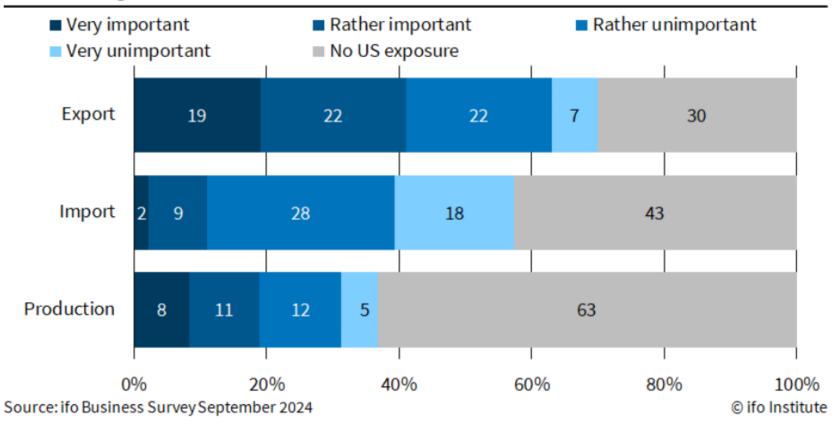




Impact of Trump Election: Exposure to the US Economy

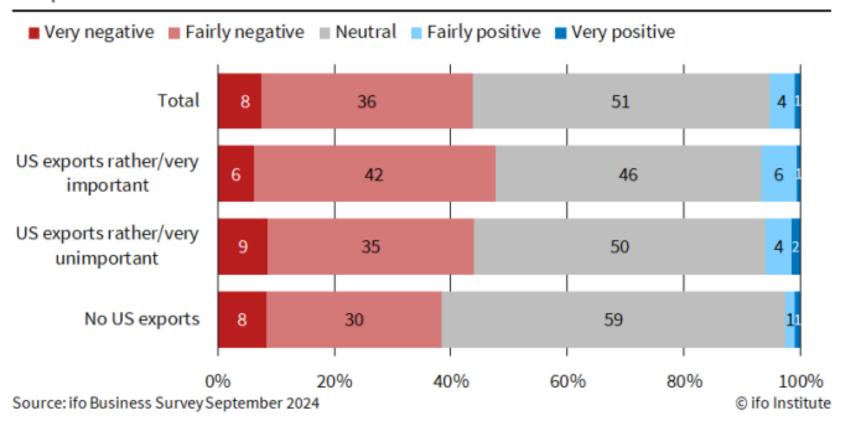
